This home is designed to create a warm resort setting that balances traditional forms and materials with contemporary living. The house is organized on one level as three pavilions that are connected with low, open links. Dry-stacked New York Bluestone walls, a Copper shingle roof and Cedar Timbers for pergolas establish the architectural character. A pool court organizes the lakeside of the home and presents a beautiful Bluestone terrace and the Cedar pergolas that establish a strong relationship between the interior and exterior spaces. The central living space incorporates Cedar Timbers, large windows for ample daylight and a Bluestone fireplace.
